

Staying Offsite at Focus 2024

At Focus, we love it when Churches camp together, however we understand that camping is not easy for everyone. So try and make the event as accessible as possible, we have put together some information on what you can expect from Focus 2024 if staying offsite.

Parking

Each year we work hard to improve on our onsite parking experience. This year we're looking to provide specific parking for those staying offsite, providing easy access to vehicles for a smooth arrival and departure each day. If you're coming via taxi, there will be a designated area for taxi drop off and pick up each day. These areas will be clearly signposted and there will be a short walk on our roadways to the gate before joining the festivities.

Tickets

If you decide to stay offsite, don't forget to book your Focus tickets via the website (https://focus.htb.org) you will need these to access site. You can book full event tickets now! We'll have day tickets available closer to the event.

Accommodation

<u>The Olde Barn Hotel</u> – Just a 16 minute drive from the showground, this is the perfect location for staying offsite. Use the code **SHOWGROUND** at checkout for a special Focus rate whilst availability lasts.

<u>Belton Woods Hotel</u> – Half an hour from site, the Belton Woods Hotel has lots of space for relaxation after a busy day at Focus. Be sure to book early for a reduced rate and check their website for further offers.

<u>Best Western Deincourt Hotel</u> – Based in Newark, the Deincourt Hotel is just a short drive from site, a great place for quick trips to and from Focus.

<u>Ivy Farm</u> – Ivy Farm is just 8 minutes from the showground, and offers self-catering or BnB accommodation.

<u>Travelodge</u> – Based in Newark, the Travelodge is just 4 miles from site, a nice quick journey to and from Focus.
