Role Context

Focus is a chance for our church and network to spend quality time together; to pitch in as a family, sharing food, receiving and praying for one another, and supporting each other as we grow. Each member of this team plays a vital role in making Focus an extraordinary experience for our church network.

Role Purpose

To play your part in making Focus happen! Working as part of the production team across the FOCUS site, helping the team to deliver an amazing experience for the many events & services that happen across the week.

Work Expectations

- The production team support Focus across many venues during the event, we are onsite Thursday 25th to Sunday 28th July 2024.
- We offer a range of volunteer slots ranging from Early Mornings, Mornings, Afternoons, Lates and Late Evenings.
- The hours for these shifts vary depending on your role, shifts may be longer than other volunteer teams (up to 7 Hours) however we will ensure you have plenty of down time for breaks and have an opportunity to enjoy FOCUS as well as play your part.

Key Responsibilities

Your key responsibilities will depend on the role you undertake during the week and may encompass multiple areas of serving. Roles include but are not limited to:

- Camera operating (holding and operating cameras in the main and youth big top)
- Cable bashing (providing support and safety for camera operators by cable managing equipment)
- Stage managing/tech/hand (directing traffic on/off stage, carrying equipment on/off stage, distributing microphones etc)
- Sound engineering – mixing live bands and handheld microphones
- Lighting engineering – providing event lighting for services and events
- Vision mixing – inputting and displaying media/images/videos etc on screens
- Song words engineer – displaying lyrics during worship
- Venue Crew – helping production ground staff to maintain equipment on site, lift and carry, move equipment etc.

Essential Skills

- Trained in a key responsibility outlined above and serving in your church
- Flexibility – able to move to different activities or time schedules if needed
- Responsible – able to carry out non-work related skills (being contactable, punctual, resilient)

- Able to work well as part of a team – serving the rest of the volunteers and staff and maintain a friendly and positive attitude

Working Environment

- Outdoor and indoor work in hot and/or adverse weather conditions
- Some roles require long standing/moving times
- Some roles require extended sitting time
- Some roles require lots of walking and lifting of heavy equipment
